## BRA FITTING GUIDE

## (A) Band Measurements

Measure all round the body underneath the bust, with an even tension i.e not too tight and not too slack.

If the number you measure is an even number add 4 inches.
If the number you measure is an odd number add 5 inches.
This gives you your band size.
For example
32" + 4" = 36 band size
$31 "+5 "=36$ band size

## (B) Cup Size

Measure with the bra on, from the centre of the sternum around the fullest part of the breast to the centre of the spine.

Double this measurement to give you your cup size.
For example
18 " $\times 2=36$ cup size $=A$ cup

## Bra Size

Now you have A \& B measurements, subtract your band measurements from your cup size to give you your bra size.

## For example:

$36 "$ band and $36 "=0$ the size would be 36 A
$36 "$ band and $37 "=+1$ the size would be $36 B$

For every +1 " you continue to go up a cup size
